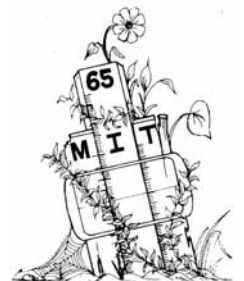
In addition to the general MIT reunion activities, the committee is planning some special events just for our class.
