Council Member Khan has a long record of community service. He served as the President of the Pakistani - American Association of Greater Houston, Vice President of the Islamic Society of Greater Houston, and a member of the Board of Directors. Council Member Khan also served on the Small Business Advisory Board of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission.

Known for his leadership in the community, Council Member Khan has been honored by the City of Houston and numerous organizations, receiving the *President's Appreciation Award* from the Pakistani - American Association of Greater Houston (PAGH) in 1995; *Torch Bearer Award* from the Pakistan American Congress (PAC) in 2004; *2004 Father of the Year Award*; *2004 Pride Award*; *Friends of Filipinos Award* in 2004; and along with his wife, received a proclamation from the City of Houston in 2004 for outstanding community service.

Council Member Khan has been married for 31 years to Dr. Attiya Khan, a renowned Cardiologist in Houston and the first female cardiology fellow at the Texas Heart Institute. Together, he and his wife have one son, Faraz, husband to Mrs. Sarah Ashraf. Council Member Khan serves on the Board of Directors for Asia Society Texas, Holocaust Museum Houston and as an Advisory Director for the Houston West Chamber of Commerce. He has recently been appointed to the Transportation Infrastructure & Services Steering committee with the National League of Cities.

Council Member Khan has pledged to be a full time city council member. He is working tirelessly to address citizen complaints and concerns and has pledged to make this process more efficient and accessible through his District Office located inside Sharpstown Mall at 7500 Bellaire Boulevard. He has continued outreach through his neighborhood office and is working to expand its resources so that residents have a more valuable outlet to obtain information, request services and voice complaints.

Council Member Khan is focusing on capital improvement projects in District F. CIP dollars determine the amount and level of infrastructure improvements throughout the City of Houston. In addition to focusing on capital improvement projects in District F, the Council Member currently serves on five committees: Flooding and Drainage, Housing and Community Development, Ethics, Public Safety and Homeland Security, Budget and Fiscal Affairs and chairs the International Liaison and Protocol Committee.
